This presentation will highlight what the GHS is, how the OSHA Hazard Communication standard will be changed, and what will be the dates when employers and chemical manufacturers, importers and distributors of chemical products will need to comply with the new requirements.

Jorge Delucca Bio: Jorge Delucca was born and raised in Puerto Rico. He graduated from the University of Puerto Rico with a Bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering and a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant in the US Air Force. After a 20 year career in the US Air Force, most of it as a Bioenvironmental Engineer, he retired and worked for 6 years as Environmental, Safety and Health Engineer in private industry. Jorge was an adjunct instructor of Environmental Science and Ethics at the University of Phoenix, Oklahoma City Campus. In October 2003, Jorge started working for the OSHA Dallas Area Office as a bilingual (Spanish) Industrial Hygienist. In October 2008 he was transferred to the Oklahoma City Area Office as Assistant Area Director. In October 2011 he became a Compliance Assistance Specialist. He has a Master of Science in Environmental Management from the University of Oklahoma and a Master of Arts in Business Administration from Webster University.

David Bates Bio: David Bates began his career with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) in 1983 as a Compliance Officer in the Little Rock, Arkansas. During his 25 years with OSHA he has worked as a Compliance Officer in the Dallas and Fort Worth Area Offices; an Assistant Area Director in the Bridgeport, CT Area Office; and an Assistant Area Director in the Little Rock, AR Area Office. Mr. Bates holds a Bachelors of Science in Industrial Technology from University of Central Arkansas in Conway, Arkansas.
